Job Task Assignments:

Responds to both natural and man made disasters or emergencies and provide for the protection of life and property. Performing Traffic and Crowd control functions. Attends Training and Policy meetings as required. Maintains advanced level of traffic safety warning lights upon personal vehicle.

Performing traffic flow control and crowd control as assigned.

Supervision:

Duties include but are not limited to:

1. Traffic control as required.
2. Crowd control as required.
3. Perform public relations interacting with motoring public.
4. Establish Emergency Detour routes, recognizing the impact upon public safety within the selected Detour Route.
5. Develop Preplans for incidents requiring full or partial road closures on LAH, Primary and secondary roads.
6. Operate and perform minor maintenance on Fire Police apparatus and equipment.
7. Be responsible for issued personal fire police equipment.
8. Maintain qualifications and Attend required training sessions and seminars.
9. Coordinate response as required under mutual aid plans.

3. Minimum CT state Fire Police Officer certification.
4. Minimum completion of a National Safety Councils Traffic Control Flagging course.
5. Demonstrate Knowledge of the confusing Colchester Street system.
6. Demonstrate Knowledge of Location of Colchester Public buildings and facilities.
7. Understanding of CHVFD SOP's and SOG's particularly as applied to Traffic.
